State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Dollars,  
to me in hand paid by Alice Garrison of Greenville County in  
the State aforesaid have granted, bargained sold and released and by  
these presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said  
Alice Garrison one tract or parcel of land lying and being in the  
state and County aforesaid on both sides of the Gap Creek Road  
joining lands with Bright and Wilson, James Garrison, Benj. Garrison  
Nancy Pender and others beginning corner at a red oak thence  
across the branch to a rock thence across said branch to a stake  
thence as strait line to a pine on James Garrison line thence to the  
Creek to a stake thence up the Creek to a stake thence a strait line  
to a post oak on the line between myself and Benj. Garrison thence  
a strait line to a Chestnut on the head of a Branch thence a strait  
line to the top of Packs Mountain thence a strait line to the top  
of Busatoll Hill to a post oak thence a strait line to a Chestnut corner  
on the Gap Creek road thence a strait line to the red oak the begin-  
ning corner containing three hundred and eighty eight and a  
half acres more or less, also all my stock of horses cattle hogs  
and sheep, together with all my household and kitchen furniture together  
with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appur-  
tenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident  
or appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular the  
premises before mentioned unto the said Alice Garrison her heirs  
and assigns forever, And I hereby bind myself my heirs  
executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all  
and singular the said real and personal property above mentioned  
unto the said Alice Garrison her heirs and assigns against me and  
my heirs and against every person or persons wheresoever  
lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof,

year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy  
nine and in the year one hundred and second of the sovereignty  
and independence of the United States of America

I Jeremiah Cleveland of Greenville  
in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of one Dollar to me  
paid by William Chorice junior of Greenville in the said State have  
granted, bargained sold and released, and by these presents, do grant  
bargain sell and release, unto the said William Chorice junior all  
that tract of land lying and being in the District of Greenville and state  
aforesaid on the waters of Richland Creek Beginning at a post oak corner  
and running 647.50 to a small Hickory near the old road to Spartanburg  
thence S 45 W 20, 25 to a Sourwood on the bank of the Tan Yard Branch  
thence up the meanders of said branch, excepting what Judge Thompson  
conveyed to David Herring at the Tan Yard, say about one acre to a  
white oak over short distance above the Tan Yard, and thence North 11 E 6.85  
to the beginning and also excepting out of the above described tract about four  
acres sold off by me and conveyed to Mrs Mary Atkinson which is taken off  
at the west end of the said tract, all the balance I hereby give and convey to  
the said William Chorice jun<sup>r</sup> being a tract conveyed to me by Waddy  
Thompson Sen<sup>r</sup> by deed dated the 11<sup>th</sup> day of April 1818. Together with  
all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to  
the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, to  
have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the  
said William Chorice Jr his and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind  
myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever  
defend all and singular the said premises, unto the said William  
Chorice Jr his and assigns, against myself and my heirs only.  
Witness my hand and seal this thirteenth day of May in the year of  
our Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty three and in the  
fifty seventh year of the Independence of the United States of  
America
