of the sum of Two hundred and fifty Dollars to me paid by Mary  
Drawdy in the State aforesaid, have granted bargained sold and  
released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto  
the said Mary Drawdy all that lot of land situate on John Street in  
the City of Greenville adjoining lots of J W Davis and Mrs Oliver  
Beginning on a stake 370 on John Street thence S 40 W 165 feet to a  
stake 370 thence along Mrs Oliver's line S 57 1/4 E 132 feet to a stake  
370 thence along J W Davis line N 40 E 165 feet to a stake 370  
on John Street thence along said Street N 50 1/4 W 132 feet to the begin-  
ning. Together with all and singular the rights members heredita-  
ments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in  
anywise incident or appertaining, To have and to hold all and sing-  
ular the premises before mentioned unto the said Mary Drawdy her  
heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs  
executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and  
singular the said premises unto the said Mary Drawdy her heirs  
and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and all others lawfully  
claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof

men by these presents that I William  
A Moore of the County and State aforesaid,

as well for and in consideration of the love and affection which I  
have and bear towards my daughter Emma J Howell wife of A M Howell Esq  
of the City and County of Greenville in the same State, as for the sum of one  
Dollar, lawful money of the United States to me in hand paid by the said  
Emma J Howell at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents,  
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have given granted aliened con-  
fessed released conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents, do give  
grant alien sufficiency, release, convey and confirm unto the said Emma  
J Howell, all that lot or parcel of land situate lying and being in the  
City and County of Greenville and State aforesaid bounded on the  
North by Washington Street, on the East by lot of Mrs Emma Har-  
rison, on the South by Haynes and Bowen and on the West by an  
alley ten feet wide separating it from lot of W A Moore, being the  
lot conveyed to me by Mrs Emma Harrison by her deed dated May  
21st 1878 and on the same day recorded in Book 10 d, page 675 in the  
office of the Register of Meuse conveyance of Greenville County, con-  
taining one fifth of one acre more or less, and having such shapes  
buttings, boundaries and descriptive marks as are represented by a plat  
of the same hereto attached, surveyed by H P Johnson on the 21st May  
1878 (2) all that lot or strip of land adjoining the above described lot  
on the West, fronting on Washington Street ten feet and extending by  
parallel lines the entire length of said lot, and marked and represented  
in the plat above mentioned as an alley 10 feet wide, Together with  
all and singular the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances there-  
unto belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, and the reversions  
and reversions, remainder and remainders rents issues and profits  
thereof, To have and to hold the said hereby granted and described  
premises, and every part and parcel thereof with the appurtenances  
unto the said Emma J Howell, for and during the term of her  
natural life, and at her death to her surviving child or children, and  
in default of child or children to her husband A M Howell, to her  
them only proper use benefit and behoof forever, and I the said W A  
Moore do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators  
to warrant and forever defend the said premises unto the said  
Emma J Howell and her heirs from and against myself and my  
heirs and all persons whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim  
the same or any part thereof
