177 feet and bounded on N.E. by R.M. Pickens lot and on  
N.W. by lot No. 5 and known on Plat as lots No 5 and 6.  
(Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments  
and appurtenances to said premises belonging or in anywise  
incidental or appertaining unto R.M. Pickens, Nancy W. Murff,  
and Samuel Wyatt and their successors or trustees.) To have and to  
hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto said trustees  
for said M.P. Church; and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors  
and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and  
singular the said premises for said M.P. Church against myself  
my heirs and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming  
or to claim the same or any part thereof.

and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto  
the said Nancy C. Hughes her heirs and assigns forever and  
I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators  
to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said pre-  
mises unto the said Nancy C. Hughes her heirs and assigns against  
me and my heirs or any other person lawfully claiming or to  
claim the same or any part thereof.
