that I, John H Houston, of
the County of Greenville in

the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1500) to me paid by Sallie F Earle of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid, have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Sallie F Earle - all those two certain pieces, parcels and lots of land situate lying and being in the County of Greenville in said State, about one and three quarter miles from Greenville S.E. on both sides of the Laurens Road - adjoining lands of Goldsmith Deed and Glenn, and having the following lines, metes and bounds, to wit: Lot No 1 beginning at a stake in the middle of the Laurens road, and running thence S 62° W 34.50 to a stake; thence S 37° E 14.75 to a stake; thence N 52° E 37.25 to a stake; in the center of said Laurens Road; thence N 58° W 9 chains to the beginning, containing forty two and four tenths acres, more or less - Lot No 2 - beginning at a stake in the center of the Laurens Road and running thence N 37 1/2° E 10.20 to a stake; thence N 66 1/4° E 16.25 to a stone; thence N 25° W 2.80 to a stone; thence S 66 1/4° W 29.75 to a stake in the center of said Laurens Road (Dee's corner); thence S 58° E 8.50 along the center of said Road - to the beginning, containing eight and seven eighths, acres more or less being portions of tracts conveyed to Wm Goldsmith, by B Manly Jr 1st January 1872, and by said Wm Goldsmith to N C Goldsmith 13th January 1877, and by said Wm and N C Goldsmith to me 25 July 1877.
