or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the
premises before mentioned unto the said Andrew M Runion
his heirs and assigns forever, and we do hereby bind our-
selves, our heirs executors and administrators, to warrant
and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto
the said Andrew M Runion his heirs and assigns, against

Corner and running thence N 48 E 28.50 to a Rock corner 3 +
nm thence S 19 E 18.34 to Post Oak 3 x nm thence S 62 1/2 W 29
to a Rock 3 x nm thence N 5.00 to the beginning corner con-
taining thirty two acres more or less "Reserving to myself
a life estate in the above tract of land" Together with all and
