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in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Eighty Dollars to me in hand paid by Paul J. Verdin of Greenville County in the State aforesaid have granted bargain'd sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Paul J. Verdin a certain piece parcel or tract of land containing ten acres be the same more or less situate in Greenville County and State aforesaid on Branches of Kilders creek Branch waters of Enoree River being a part of the Estate of L S Heamby deceased beginning at Rock 3 x 2 m near the road leading to McSee Factory thence N 30 W 15.93 ch to Rock 3 x 2 m thence S 22 1/4 W 26.58 ch to Rock 3 x 2 m by a road thence S 75 1/2 E 4.54 ch to Rock 3 x 2 m to Waldrup and Fowlers corners thence N 49 1/2 E 18.08 ch along said Factory road to the beginning Rock 3 x 2 m the above bearings and distances includes ten acres of S R Heamby's deed. 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have this day for and in consideration of divers reasons I have this day give my daughter Julia Ann Davis to W A Jennings and his wife Nancy A Jennings to keep until she is at 18 years of age she is now 9 years of age 10th day of March 1877 I John Davis do hereby bind myself my heirs to never take the said child from the said W A Jennings and N A Jennings until she be 18 years of age and W A Jennings and N A Jennings do agree on our part do agree to take the said child and treat her with the same care as we would a child of our own and teach her good morals and feed and clothe her in
