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State aforesaid, send greeting: Whereas by virtue of a writ of Fieri Facias, issued out of the Court of Common Pleas, held for the County of Greenville, tested the nineteenth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy eight at the suit of Gideon Thompson and Manning Thompson, as Executors of John T. Thompson to and directed
