West 3. 8. 1 chs. to stone corner thence S. 0 4 1/2 W. 1. 75 chs. to stake in fence thence S. 90 E. 3 chains to the beginning adjoining lot of William Chandler on the East line and lands of the said Emuala B. and Elizabeth E. Jones on the other three sides.
