Greenville County Greenville Township on the Neely Ferry Road and in the State aforesaid. Beginning at a stone 8 x 8 on the East side of the aforesaid Road near Thos Goldsmith Spring Thence N 77 W 4 7/7 to a poplar 87 5 m thence S 2 1/2 W 8 00 to a Oak tree 87 7 m thence S 33 1/4 E 6 10 to a Corn in the Neely Ferry Road thence N 7 1/2 E 12 08 to the beginning stone 8 x above the Spring containing three and one half acres more or less together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining; To have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said T B Goldsmith his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said T B Goldsmith his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs or any other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
