Know all men by these presents that I S G Learuth
of Spartanburg County
and State aforesaid in the State aforesaid, for and in
consideration of the sum of Four hundred and fifty
Dollars to me paid by Thomas M Belue of the County
aforesaid in the State aforesaid have granted, bargained
and sold and by these presents do grant bargain
and sell to the said S G Learuth

all that tract or parcel of land lying and being in Greenville
County and State aforesaid on mill creek waters of South Pacolet
River joining lands of A Dill, J Pease and others, beginning on
a Red Oak on Pease's line David Barton's corner thence S 65 W
14.20 crossing the creek to a stake thence N 68 W 11.60 to a
Red Oak, thence N 42 W 6.80 to a Post Oak, thence N 68 W 15
to a Sour Wood thence N 35 E 41 to a Post Oak thence S 4 W
9.60 to a Chestnut thence S 6 E 10 to a Sour wood thence S 7 E
13 to a Stake thence S 5 E 23.70 to a Chestnut thence N 65
E 2.8 to a Red Oak thence S 43 E 32.80 to a Post Oak thence
N 65 E 25.15 to a Stake thence N 45 W 16.30 to the beginning
