following land, to wit: Forty seven  $\frac{1}{2}$  Acres more or less in  
Greenville County, State aforesaid being lot No 7 of the  
Cleveland Tract and having such shape and form as are  
represented by a plat of said land on record in the  
office of the Secretary of State. Together with all and sing-  
ular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenan-  
ces to the said premises belonging, or in anywise in-  
cident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and sing-  
ular the premises before-mentioned unto the said J  
M Kemp his heirs and assigns forever, and the  
State aforesaid does hereby bind itself to warrant and  
forever defend all and singular the said premises unto  
the said J. M. Kemp his heirs and assigns against  
all persons who may lawfully claim or to claim  
the same, or any part thereof.

that is to say, to ask, demand, sue for, collect, receive and  
give acquittance for all sums of money, debts, and demands  
whatsoever which are or shall be due, owing, and belong-  
ing to me; to ask, demand, distrain for, collect, and  
receive all such rents, and arrears of rents as now are or  
may hereafter be due or owing to me; to receive the di-  
vidends which are or shall be payable on any stocks or  
bonds standing in my name; to sell transfer and assign  
the same; to exercise a general supervision and control  
over all my lands tenements and hereditaments and prevent  
by all lawful means the commission of any trespass  
or waste or other injury thereto; to lease for any term  
or term of years any of my said lands, tenements
