have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant bargain sell and release, unto the
said Sarah L. Bramlett a certain piece parcel or tract
of land, containing forty eight acres be the same
more or less, situated in Greenville County and State
aforesaid, on a small branch of Rocky creek Branch
waters of Curves River beginning at R. O. 3 x 0.2 m.
Down, Rock thence N 66 1/4 W 15.72 ch to a stake 8 x
0.4 m thence N 87 1/2 W 12.73 ch to a Rock 3 x 0.2 m.
thence S 9 W 15.75 ch to a Rock 3 x 2 m thence S 60
E 20.34 ch to a Rock on W P. Grisham line 8 x 2 m
thence N 88 E 15.56 ch along said line to a Chestnut
Stump 3 x 0.2 m by a small black Jack 8 x each
thence N 30 1/2 E 6.60 ch to the beginning R. O. down
Rock with Reference to a Plat hereto annexed
together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any
wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and
singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said
