 shall come or be made known

or whom the same may in anywise concern. I S. J. Douthick  
 Master of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid, send  
 greeting. Whereas a petition was filed in the Probate Court  
 for said State and County, on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of October 1875  
 by Meajah B. Harrison and Anna M. Harrison, to  
 partition the real estate of Nancy Harrison deceased,  
 and whereas the said real estate was partially partitioned  
 under said proceedings, and whereas it has since  
 been decided by the Supreme Court that the Probate  
 Court was without jurisdiction in such cases, and  
 whereas it became necessary to institute proceedings  
 in the Court of Common Pleas for the State and  
 County aforesaid to confirm the said partition, and  
 whereas a complaint was filed in said Court of Com-  
 mon Pleas on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of October 1879, by Meajah  
 B. Harrison against James B. Harrison and  
 others, and upon the hearing of said cause, the said  
 Court amongst other things, did order, adjudge and  
 decree that the said partition be confirmed, and that  
 the master should execute to the present owners of  
 the respective tracts of land confirmatory titles thereto,  
 and whereas W. A. McKeloy is still the present owner  
 of the tract of land purchased by him in said proce-  
 dings in the Probate Court. Now therefore know  
 all men by these presents, that I S. J. Douthick Master  
 in and for the County and State aforesaid in

consideration of the premises, and of the sum of three Dollars  
 paid me by the said W. A. McKeloy, the receipt whereof is hereby  
 acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and  
 by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the  
 said W. A. McKeloy and his heirs and assigns, all that tract  
 of land, situate, lying and being, in the County of Greenville  
 and State aforesaid, bounded by lands of Mrs. M. J. Gray  
 said W. A. McKeloy and others, and containing eighty five  
 acres, more or less, being more particularly described in the  
 deed from the Probate Judge to the said W. A. McKeloy,  
 together with all and singular the rights, members, heredita-  
 ments and appurtenances whatsoever, to the said tract  
 of land, belonging, or in any wise appertaining, and the  
 reversions and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof.  
 And also all the estate, right, title, interest, dower, possession,  
 property, benefit, claim and demand whatsoever, both  
 at law and in equity of the said Nancy Harrison, deceased  
 and of all the parties to the said suit, and of all other  
 persons rightfully claiming or to claim the same,  
 or any part thereof, by, from or under them, or either  
 of them, To have and to hold the said tract of land with  
 its hereditaments, privileges and appurtenances unto  
 the said W. A. McKeloy, his heirs and assigns forever.
