of the State and County aforesaid and Pickens McCoey
of the State and County aforesaid do agree to the fol-
lowing contract to wit: - John Bates of the first part
rents his place unto Pickens McCoey on the following
conditions for three years for the first year one
hundred bushels of corn to be delivered unto the
said John Bates on the premises before any of
the crop is removed from the place, - the other two
years the said John Bates and Pickens McCoey is to give one
hundred and twenty five bushels each year the
rent to be paid under the same arrangement as the
first year. The said Pickens McCoey is to put the
fences in good repair the first year and keep
them in good repair the said Pickens McCoey re-
mains the right of being relieved of the contract at
the expiration of the first year 1881. The said Pickens
McCoey can let it up again on a partition and
divide it into four parts and let them to Pickens McCoey
