Beginning on a stone & x thence N 44 1/8 W. 15. 78 to stake & x in the Piedmont Factory Road thence Road line to the cross of the Williamston Road line to a stone & x thence N 85 1/4 W. 15. ch. 28.5 to a stone & x near to the Golden Grove Chapel Church thence N 1/4 W. 4. ch. 45 to a stone & x thence N. 44 1/8 E. 16. 8. 2. 1/2 to the beginning stone corner containing fifty four and one fourth acres. be the same more or less Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments appertinances appertaining in any wise incident to the above described land I bind myself my heirs executors aduor and assigns to warrant and forever defend all and singular of the above described land unto Henrietta Shockley her heirs and assigns forever against myself my heirs executors aduor and assigns and against any person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. I also delegate the right to change the road leading from the Williamston to the Golden Grove Chapel, to Henrietta Shockley her heirs & assigns.
