Anderson his executors administrators and assigns forever the said buildings above mentioned and all the estate right title interest terms property claim and demand whatsoever which I have of in or to the same or any part thereof. To have and to hold the same unto the said George W. Anderson his heirs executors administrators and assigns to his and their only proper use and behoof forever.
