rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said
premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining
To have and to hold all and singular the premises before
mentioned unto the said Wm Mitchell his heirs and assigns
forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors
administrators and assigns to warrant and forever defend
all and singular the said premises unto the said William
Mitchell his heirs and assigns forever and against myself
my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully
claiming the same or any part thereof.
