der, Tracts Nos 2 and 3 of Estate of William Rainey deceased
beginning at a Pine 8 x 6 m thence N 30° E fifteen chains to
a Rock 40 m thence S 42° E seventeen chains and fifty
links to a Chestnut stake + W thence S 30° W fourteen
chains and eighty three links to a stake + W thence
W seventeen chains and fifty links to the beginning
corner, and containing twenty five acres more or less
being part of the lands of William Rainey deceased,
