the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand and fifty dollars to me in hand paid by Miles Hendrix of Greenville County in the State aforesaid, have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Miles Hendrix all that tract piece or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid on both sides of Bellengers Creek waters of Coore River adjoining lands of Miles Hendrix, G. P. Mayfield, Manning Dillard &c and others containing one hundred and one half acres more or less, it being a part of the same tract of land conveyed by H. P. Hammett to J. M. Thomas by deed dated 6<sup>th</sup> of April 1875 and by the heirs of H. P. Hammett and the said H. P. Hammett to me by deed dated 6<sup>th</sup> of April 1875, Beginning at a stone 3 x 3 x 0 m formerly red oak (down) and running thence N 45 1/2 E 128.63 ch to a Hickory 3 x 3 x 0 m (dead) thence S 75 3/4 W 41.61 ch to a Post Oak 3 x 3 x 0 m (down) thence N 14 1/4 W 8.72 ch to a Persimmon 3 x 0 m thence S 51 1/4 W 9.52 ch to a stone formerly Hickory 3 x 3 x 0 m thence N 81 W 10.00 ch crossing Bellengers Creek to a stone 3 x 0 m thence S 2 1/4 W 7.22 ch to a W. O. 3 x 0 m thence S 68 E 2.50 ch crossing Bellengers Creek to a Post Oak 3 x 0 m thence S 63 1/2 E 17.72 ch to the beginning. Together with all and singular the rights, members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold, all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Miles Hendrix his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Miles Hendrix his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs, and against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same in any
