Know all men by these presents
that I, James B. Tarrant of
the County of Greenville

in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of
one thousand Dollars to me paid by Harriet T. Garrison
of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid, have
granted bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant bargain, sell and release unto the
said Harriet T. Garrison, all of my right, title, claim
interest or demands, in that certain piece, parcel or tract
of land, situate, lying and being in the County and
State aforesaid on waters of Currier River, adjoining
lands of H. Bishop, E. Nix and others, beginning near
maple corner on branch below Currier Church Spring, thence
with the meanderings of said branch 11 chs. to poplar, thence
S 85 E 18 25 to a Rock corner on the Road, thence up said
road N 75 to a stake, thence N 87 W 3 70 to a stump at the
head of Branch, thence with the meanders of said
branch 26 chs to a Run, across the River to the mouth
of dry ditch, thence up said ditch to hill ditch, thence
along said hill ditch to dream ditch, thence up said
dream ditch 88 chs to mouth of an other hill ditch, thence
S 9 1/2 W 1 75 to a Poplar, thence S 81 E 2 chs to a Sycamore
on River ditch, thence S 59 E 2 70 to a P. O. thence S 2 W 21
chs to the beginning corner, and containing one hundred
and twenty three acres more or less, Being the same
tract of land conveyed to the said Harriet T. Garrison
by J. B. Dennis, as guardian of myself by deed bearing
date the 12th of February 1876 and recorded in Register
"meane conveyance Book 26 p. 28. Together with all
and singular the right, members, here detriments and
appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in
anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to
hold, all and singular the said premises before
mentioned unto the said Harriet T. Garrison her
heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind
myself my heirs, executors and administrators to
maintain and forever defend the same unto the

Garrison her heirs and assigns, against me and my
heirs, and every other person or persons whomsoever
lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part
thereof.
