County in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, released and
by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto
the said M. C. Durham, all that piece parcel or tract
of land situate lying and being in Greenville County
in the State aforesaid on Naughton's Creek waters of
Pacoleh River, containing one hundred and thirty
four Acres more or less, being the tract of land
conveyed to me by W. A. McDaniel Esq. by deed
bearing date 6th August 1855, having been sold by
him as the property of Daniel Harrison
together with all and singular the rights, members
hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises
belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining;
to have and to hold, all and singular the said premises
before mentioned unto the said M. C. Durham his
heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind
myself my heirs executors and administrators, to warrant
and forever defend all and singular the said premises
unto the said M. C. Durham his heirs and assigns against
me and my heirs and all other persons lawfully claiming
or to claim the same or any part thereof.
