 Sallie M. Gower. M. Westfield Whittier Dymmer
 Plaintiff exhibited their

Complaint for Relief &c. in the Court of Common
 Pleas for the County of Greenville and State aforesaid
 against Thomas M. Goff, Thomas G. Gower William
 Binnie and others Defendants, whereas amongst
 other things it was alleged that said John Westfield
 now deceased on the day of A. D. 1873 sold
 and conveyed to the Plaintiff Whittier Dymmer and
 Thomas M. Goff & Thomas G. Gower the Defendants
 and to said James Binnie, also now deceased, all
 sundry four (4-5) Lots of land situate in certain
 Real Estate in and among the City of Greenville
 in the County & State aforesaid and more particu-
 larly described in the Deed of Conveyance of that
 date and on the 30th day of September A. D. 1873. the
 said John Westfield agreed to sell to the firm of
 Goff Binnie & Co. (which was composed of himself
 and other parties last above named) certain other
 Lots, pieces or parcels of land situate near the
 said City of Greenville County and State aforesaid
 and more particularly described in said
 agreement and that the said parties who were
 interested in the lands above mentioned in order
 to facilitate the sale and transfer of said lands
 had agreed to also amongst themselves to
 convey all of the said lands in trust to two of
 their number to sell and divide the proceeds
 of sale amongst the parties according to their
 respective interests as they should appear

things that these matters might be inquired into and if
 found advisable to carry out the said agreement in reference to a
 Trust Deed that a suitable Trust Deed be reported together
 with some suitable persons or persons to act as Trustees or Trustees
 and whereas upon the said Deed being heard on the 17th day of
 June A. D. 1874 it was referred to a Special Referee to report
 on the matters matters embraced in the pleadings in said
 Cause and upon the report of said Special Referee coming
 in containing the said recommendations therein more fully
 set forth it was on the 7th day of August A. D. 1874 amongst
 other things ordered that Whittier Dymmer & Thomas G. Gower
 be appointed Trustees to whom William A. McDaniel Clerk
 of the said Court should convey the said lands to have &
 to have the same to for and upon the purposes uses and
 trusts as set forth and declared in the Deed reported by the
 said Referee and whereas the said William A. McDaniel Clerk
 of the said Court should convey the lands mentioned in
 the pleadings to the said Trustees, now there remains
 all owing by these presents that is to say Thomas G. Gower
 and Whittier Dymmer Trustees as aforesaid by virtue
 of the power conferred upon us in and by the order
 and Trust Deed aforesaid upon the written request
 of the certain Trust Deed herein produced and in
 performance of our duty as such Trustees and
 also in consideration of the sum of Twenty Five
 Dollars to us paid by Mrs Sallie M. Gower before
 the delivery of these presents have granted bargained
 sold and released and by these presents do grant
 bargain sell and release unto the said Mrs
 Sallie M. Gower and that piece parcel or Lot of
 land being parcels of the lands above mentioned
 situate lying in the City and County of Green-
 ville in the State aforesaid commencing at a
 stake on Binnie Street North West corner of lot
 formerly sold to Weston Dickson measuring there
 328 1/2 & Two hundred and Seventeen feet and
 half of one foot to state on said line
 36 1/2 & fifty feet to Dickson Lot thence N 28 E
 Two hundred and Seventeen feet and one half of one
 foot to said Dickson line to state on said line
