(The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John E. Smith a certain piece parcel or tract of land containing Seventy three acres be the same more or less situated in Butler Township of Greenville County in the State aforesaid on both sides of Long Branch of Rocky Creek Branch waters of Enoee River on both sides of the Road leading from Datersville to Greenville City. Beginning at a stone 6x6 m on Dry Branch thence N 23 1/2 W 1.84 to a stone 3x2 m thence N 63 W 12.00 to a stone 3x2 m thence N 11 1/2 E 13.17 to a stone 3x2 m thence N 19 1/4 E 8.74 to a stone on the said Road thence across said Road N 6 E 0.60 to a R.O. 5x0 m Holighly corner thence N 44 W 13.92 to a Rock 3x0 m thence S 13 3/8 W 11.46 to a R.O. 3x0 m thence S 12 W 2.50 to a Rock 3x0 m thence S 12 W 4.40 to a water oak 3x0 m thence down the meanders of said Dry Branch to the beginning corner. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.
