Davis a certain tract piece or parcel of land lying and being in the State and County of aforesaid on the North side of the Tugalow Road and East of Trammels Beaver dam Creek Branch waters of Middle Tyger River and bounded by lands of M. L. Davis and John Campbell and runs as follows beginning on a white Oak on the Tugalow Road thence N 9 E 1/4 25 to a Post Oak thence S 76 1/2 E 9.32 to a Post Oak on the said Tugalow road thence with said road to the beginning corner containing five acres and one fourth more or less  
Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining
