these presents, that

O. H. Jenkins of Greenville County in the State  
aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Twenty  
Dollars to me paid by J. P. Baker of Greenville  
County in the State aforesaid, have granted barg-  
ained sold and release and by these presents do  
grant bargain sell and release unto the said  
J. P. Baker all that parcel or lot of land  
lying on Reedy River and being in the  
County and State aforesaid in Township  
bounded by lands of the said  
J. P. Baker and myself the same being on  
the west bank of the Reedy River

having been cut off of my tract by the River,  
cutting a new channel on the west side of the  
said lot the same beginning at a stake at the  
upper end of the old run thence down the River  
S 80 W 2, 37 to a point thence S 65 W 2, 20 to a  
stake 3x at lower end of the old run thence  
East 150 to point one thence off at right angle  
to middle of old run thence still on East line  
300 to opposite point two 80 off to middle of  
old run thence still on East line 600 to a  
point on old run thence N 5 1/4 E 100 to a point  
in middle of old run thence N 62 W 100 to a  
point opposite point three 70 limits off to old  
run thence still on said course 200 to reach  
one said run, thence S 83 1/2 W 115 to the begin-  
ing stake 3x containing one acre the  
same being more or less. Together with  
all and singular the rights, members, hereditam-  
ents and appurtenances to the said premises  
belonging, or in anywise incident or appert-  
aining. To have and to hold, all and sing-  
ular the said premises before mentioned unto  
the said J. P. Baker his heirs and assigns  
forever, and I do hereby bind myself my  
heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant  
and forever defend all and singular the  
said premises unto the said J. P. Baker  
heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs  
or any other person or persons whomsoever  
lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or  
any part thereof.
