administrators executors or assigns, all our right
title and interest in that lot tract or parcel of
land lying being and situate in Greenville Co. State
aforesaid on waters of Tyger River containing one
hundred and ninety acres more or less bounded on
South by lands of the widow Calloway, on west
by lands of the Jackson Estate, on north by lands
of Alfred Southern, on east by lands of John
