Milton Trammell of Greenville County in the State
aforesaid, have granted bargained sold and re-
leased, and by these presents do grant bargain
sell and release, unto the said Milton Trammell
all my undivided interest and claim being one
eighth interest in a certain tract piece or parcel
of land situate in the County and State aforesaid
on the low fork of musk creek waters of South
Syger River adjoining lands of Martha Callaway
Alfred Southern William Siley Allen Gosnell
and others known as the Alfred Turner tract
and now belonging to the heirs of the said
Alfred Turner deceased.

Together with all and singular the rights members
hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises
belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining
To have and to hold, all and singular the said
premises before mentioned unto the said Milton
Trammell his heirs and assigns forever,
and I do hereby bind myself my heirs exe-
cutors and administrators to warrant and
forever defend all and singular the said
premises unto the said Milton Trammell
his heirs and assigns, against me and my
heirs and every other person or persons lawfully
claiming, or to claim the same, or any part
thereof.

and release, unto the said Henry T. Pace all the
right title and interest I have in & to the follow-
ing described tract of land lying and being in
the County of Greenville and State aforesaid and a
part of the Wolf grant and adjoining lands of
Wm. Mayfield, William Turner and others
containing thirty three acres more or less and
having the following metes and bounds viz. begin-
ning on a Black Gum running N 8 3/4 E 44.90 to a
chestnut thence S 13 E 44.00 to a stump thence
S 86 1/2 W 16.00 to the beginning corner
