 state aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released
 and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release
 unto the said Downs Rosemond Austin Jenkins etc
 that that said premises shall be used kept maintained
 and disposed of as a place of divine worship for the
 use of the members and inhabitants of the Methodist
 Episcopal Church in the United States of America. Sub
 ject to the discipline and vestry ministerial appoint
 ments of said church as from time to time author
 ized and directed by the General Conference of
 said church and the Annual Conference in whose

possession or tract of land situated and lying in the town leading
 from Dr. Austins to Batesville in Greenville County and State
 of South Carolina containing one acre more or less Beginning
 on a stake at 85th E. 6th to a stake thence up the said road to a
 stone at 18th W. 3rd near a small pine thence 85th W. 6th to the
 Beginning. Bounded by church lot and Mr. W. Bramlett's land
 and others together with all and singular the rights man
 bers hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises
 belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining thereto
 to have and to hold all and singular the said premises be
 fore mentioned unto the said B. D. Downs Sam Rosemond
 Frank Austin Robert Jenkins and their successors in office
 from heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind
 myself and my heirs Executors and Administrators to
 warrant and forever defend all and singular the said pre
 mises unto the said Trustees and their successors in office
 and assigns against me and my heirs and against all
 persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same
 or any part thereof witness my hand and seal this
 10th day of February in the year of Our Lord and thousand
 eight hundred and eighty two and in the one hundred
 and seventh year of the sovereignty and independence
 of the United States of America.
