do and in consideration of the sum of Seventy five
(\$75.00) Dollars to me paid by Anna R Cox of
Greenville County in the State of aforesaid have
granted bargained sold and released and by
these presents do grant bargain sell and release
unto the said Anna R Cox all that certain tract
or lot of land in the City of Greenville State of aforesaid
and known as lot No 4 of a survey made
by James N Dickson near the depot of the Atlan-
ta & Charlotte Div of the Richmond & Danville
Rail Road, said lot more particularly described
as follows: Commencing at a stake on Northwest
corner of lot No 3 thence N 4 1/2 W 50 feet along
R R lands thence N 85 1/2 E 120 feet along a street
to stake thence S 4 1/2 E 50 feet along a street to
stake thence S 85 1/2 W 120 feet along lot No 3 to
the point of beginning the said lot being sold
by Thomas G Gower & Whitner Symmes to Thomas
M Cox July 6th 1878 and by the said Thomas M
Cox to me Mary E Cox on the fifteenth day of
August 1879 Together with all and singular
the rights members hereditaments and appurten-
ances to the said premises belonging or in
anywise incident or appertaining To have
and to hold all and singular the said premises
before mentioned unto the said Anna R Cox
her heirs and assigns forever and I do
hereby bind myself and my heirs executors
and administrators to warrant and forever
defend all and singular the said premises
unto the said Anna R Cox her heirs and assigns
against me and my heirs or any other person
lawfully claiming or to claim the same or
any part thereof in me
