Guest and William Cox and others containing two hundred and nine acres more or less known as the "McLory Place" being the tract conveyed to me by William Cox by deed bearing date the twelfth day of April ad 1876 as describ- ed in a plat made by W. A. Anderson D. S. on 21 st day of January ad 1873 Together with all and sing- ular the rights tenements hereditaments and appurten- ances to the said premises belonging or in any wise in- cident or appertaining.
