Willis of Greenville County in the State aforesaid, have granted, bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Andrew K. Willis all that piece parcel or tract of land situated lying and being in Greenville County in the State aforesaid on the North side of the Ridge Road bounded by Benjamin Howley on the East on the South by Wilson Trammell on the West by Reuben Dill on the North by Wilson Trammell containing one hundred acres more or less and being the same tract of land conveyed to D. C. Davis by Frances Forest and Nancy Mease and to D. C. Davis to Benjamin P. Trammell and John J. Coker, and the one half interest in which was conveyed to John J. Coker by the said Benjamin P. Trammell and the hold then conveyed to me by the said John J. Coker the 18<sup>th</sup> day of December 1879.

Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. Do have and to hold, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Andrew K. Willis his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind my self and my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Andrew K.
