Know all men by these presents that Benjamin Perry of Greenville County in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of four thousand Dollars to me in hand paid by William Perry and Benjamin Perry junior of Greenville County in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said William Perry & Benjamin Perry Jr one undivided half of my office lot & store house in the City of Greenville S.C. fronting about thirty feet on main street and one hundred & ten feet deep between the Grocery store of Ferguson & Millers and Druggists shop of Dr. Glaucus bounded on each side by their lots & on the rear by the lot of said Ferguson & Miller Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said William Perry & Benjamin Perry Jr jointly their heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said William Perry & Benjamin Perry junior (being one undivided half of the said office lot & store house) their heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and all other persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
