grant bargain sell and release, unto the said
Thos. W. Austin, all those three certain tracts or
parcels of land, bought by me in three sepa-
rate parcels from the heirs of Mrs Anna Shum-
ate & Henry Stokes all three tracts adjoining
and containing Two hundred and eight
acres having heretofore sold off of said
tract one hundred ten acres more or less, &
this deed is intended to convey only two
hundred & eight acres as stated above, adjoin-
ing lands of Nimrod Donaldson, Jno. O
Sullivan's Est lands Frank Austin & others &
known as my homeplace

Together with all and singular the rights, members, heredi-
taments and appurtenances to the said premises bel-
onging, or in any wise incident or appertaining;
To have and to hold all and singular the said
premises before mentioned unto the said Thos
W Austin his heirs and assigns forever,
and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and
administrators to warrant and forever defend
all and singular the said premises unto the said Thos
W Austin his heirs and assigns, against me &
my heirs, & every other person, whomsoever law-
fully claiming, or to claim the same, in any
part thereof.

thence S 41° 45' chs to stake in N. Trowbridge line thence
