Oak 3x, N 20 1/2 E 17.70 to Pine 3x near Road, N 7 1/2 E with said Road 28.10 to W. Oak 3x, N 70 1/2 E 3.59 to stone 3x, S 16 E 9.37 to P. Oak 3x, S 20 W 2.14 to P.
