bargained sold and released, and by these presents do  
grant bargain sell and release unto the said M. L.  
Donaldson a certain piece or parcel of land situate  
in Greenville County and State aforesaid on the South  
side of Long Branch of Reedy River beginning at  
a stone 3x 3x Sweet Gum down near said branch, and  
running thence N 77 1/4 E 1.50 to a stone 3x thence  
N 73 1/2 W 17.23 to a stone 3x by a Red Oak stump,  
thence N 81 1/4 W 11.00 to a stone 3x thence S 88 W 1.20  
to a Maple 3x and 20 links to the middle of said  
branch thence down said branch with stream and  
to the beginning containing eight acres more or  
less Together with all and singular the rights  
members hereditaments and appurtenances to the  
said premises belonging, or in anywise incident  
or appertaining, To have and to hold all and  
singular the said premises before mentioned  
unto the said M. L. Donaldson his heirs and assigns

and State aforesaid, Beginning at the corner of Avenue  
and 1 Street, thence running thirty four feet on  
said Avenue, Street by forty seven feet nine inches  
back and containing 1637 square feet be it the  
same more or less, Together with all and  
singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in  
anywise incident or appertaining, To have  
and to hold all and singular the premises before  
mentioned unto the said Thomas Lynch his heirs  
and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind
