in consideration of the sum of three thousand six  
hundred and twenty five Dollars to me paid by  
John H. Houston alias of the same City and County  
and in the State aforesaid, have granted bargained  
sold and released, and by these presents do grant  
bargain sell and release, unto the said John H.  
Houston, all that piece, parcel or tract of land  
situate and being in the County and State aforesaid  
about three miles west of Greenville second Branch  
on the white Horse and Pendleton road and  
upon waters of Babuda River, adjoining land

Bonsetts Cleveland and others, and containing one  
hundred and forty acres more or less, and more particularly  
described in the deed of Survey aforesaid from Julia  
A. Taylor to me, dated the 19<sup>th</sup> day of March A.D. 1881 and  
recorded in the office of Register of Deeds conveyance  
in Book K. M. N. page 19, on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of June 1881,  
in which reference is made to plat made by John  
Watson Surveyor on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of December 1881  
and annexed to a deed from Whiteford Smith to  
Robert Brewster dated the 1<sup>st</sup> day of December ad
