Hart and the State aforesaid and County of Greenville have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Wm P. Hart abstract or parcel of land, situated in Greenville County, where the same water of both Tugay River near Salley Mountain, as lot no 5, bounded by lands of S Bartlett, Charles Beawau, Wm F. Heath, James French others, Containing Sixty two acres more or less, at Burnig Well, and of land that was owned by Joseph Burnell at the death; together with all and singular the rights, moneys, credits, documents, and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining to the same to have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto him, said Wm P.
