unto the said James Shackleton All that tract of
Land situate in Greenville County in State aforesaid
adjoining lands of Thomas W. Rice, and the said James
Shackleton and Thomas as the House place of Spertan
Shoctley Deceased, containing length 40 three quarters
acres more or less, Beginning at Hickory 3x3x on near
Branch and running S 24 W 11.55 chs to center of
Spring, thence S 74 W 9.40 to a stone 3x 7 m. thence S 82 W
7.57 to a stone 3x 7 m. thence N 60 W 9.05 chs to a
stone 3x m. thence N 74 W 15.23 to a stone 3x 7 m.
thence N 82 W 9.10 chs to a stone 3x 7 m. for only a Back fork
thence N 19 W - 19 m to a post oak 3x 7 m. thence N 34 W 5.30
chs to the Beginning Hickory.
