Whereas Martha Hudson late of
Greenville County in the State aforesaid departed
this life on the eighteenth day of December eighteen
hundred and sixty three testate and a few days there-
after to wit on or about the twenty eighth day of
December of the same year this present at law
distributed all of whom were the donees and legatees
under her will and all of age made claim
of his property among themselves agreeing
themselves to perfect title to each other
respectively for the Real estate

And whereas the real estate hereinafter described
was allotted to William A. Hudson but through
some oversight Martha Austin one of said heirs
at law never acknowledged her interest therein to him

is now the property of V. P. Hudson and at the time
