To J. Deady, Thomas Hendricks, I want all mine by these pres- ents. That I, Moses Jimison of Greenville County in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Sixty dollars to me paid by Thomas Hendricks of Greenville County in the State aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Thomas Hendricks, all that piece, parcel, and lot of Land containing one acre, more or less, sit- uated in the County and State aforesaid above named, three miles west of Greenville Court House adjoining lands of Thomas Childs, W. S. Mauldin and Emanuel Robertson, being the Southern portion of a Two acre Lot conveyed to me by Emanuel Robertson by deed bearing date the 21st day of January A.D. 1878, and the lot on which I now live, said lot and house to remain as a home for me during my natural life, and subject to my control, and man- agement, together with all and singular the rights, incidents and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in any wise in anywise or appertaining. To have and to hold, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Thomas Hendricks, his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby give my self my heirs, Executors, and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Thomas Hen- dricks his heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and all other persons, whomsoever, lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof.
