Samuel J. Daubelit Pro. { The State of South Carolina,
 292 On I Deed Greenville County,
 Mary S. States Whereas, Mary S. States, Han-
 nie J. Hunter, Jessie C. Kilgour, William C. Kilgour and
 Dr. C. Kilgour filed their Petition, on the 18th day of Decem-
 ber 1896 against T. G. Kilgour and Matilda Kil-
 gour for the partition of the Real Estate of Josiah
 Kilgour deceased in the Probate Court for said County
 among said parties according to their respective
 rights. And whereas on the 16th day of April A.D.
 1884 it was ordered and adjudged by S. J. Daubelit
 Probate Judge for said County, that the tract of
 8.99 acres situated in Greenville County be granted
 levied amongst Mary S. States, Hattie J. Hunter
 and Dr. C. Kilgour in the proportion of two
 fifths to Mrs. Stocker, two fifths to Mrs. Hunter and
 one fifth to Dr. Kilgour, and witness on the 4th day
 of May A.D. 1894 a writ of Partition for the purpose
 aforesaid was issued out of the Probate Office
 for said County directed James K. Neikau, Sam
 Fowler and S. A. White, Commissioner, and whereas
 the said Commissioners did agree upon said tract
 of land in relation to said writ of Partition, and
 on the 19th day of May 1894 allotted to Mary S.
 States, Three hundred and fifty acres of said tract
 of land except a small portion cut off by a deed
 from Josiah Kilgour to Jessie C. Kilgour and value
 by said Commissioners at Twenty Four Hundred
 and Fifty dollars - which said tract of 350 acres
 said Commissioners agreed to said Mrs. States
 as her two fifths under the decree aforesaid, and
 designated the same by a plat account paying
 their return marked Plat No. 1; and whereas the
 tract of said Commissioners was examined, ap-
 proved and confirmed by me S. J. Daubelit as
 Probate Judge on the 18th day of May 1894, I now
 therefore know all men by these presents that I
 Samuel J. Daubelit Judge of the Court of Probate for
 Said County, for and in consideration of the sum
 of one dollar and also in consideration of the
 sum of Five dollars to me paid by Mary S.

States of said County, how granted, bargained sold
 and released, and by these presents do grant, bar-
 gain sell and release unto the said Mary S. States
 all that certain tract and parcel of land sit-
 ting and lying in the County of Greenville and
 State aforesaid on Gilmore and Peters Creek, begin-
 ning at a Stake 3x in Branch near a pool on 3x 3x
 90.10 in a Stake 3x 3x, down stream to 46% W 11.00, thence
 S 35% W 21.80 to a black oak stump on a road, thence
 10% W 18.94 to a white oak 3x 3x on strong timber, thence
 S 19 E 6' 0" to a Chestnut 3x gone in Gin Pond, thence
 west thence S 6% E 48.00 to a Stake 3x 3x tree, thence
 up the main divide of said Branch to the
 dividing corner, and having such notes, buttins and
 boundaries as is represented by a flat line with a
 ladder made by James K. Neikau, Deputy Surveyor
 on and recording date the 19th day of May 1894,
 containing One hundred & Fifty acres more or less
 being a tract of the Homestead tract of the late
 Josiah Kilgour, and assigned and allotted to
 Mary S. States in the proportion and division
 of the Real Estate of said Josiah Kilgour deceased, to
 gather with all and singular the rights, members
 hereditaments and appurtenances to the said
 premises belonging on in anywise in each on
 afelelding; To have and to hold all and singular
 on the premises before mentioned unto the
 said Mary S. States and her heirs and assigns
 forever. With this my hand and seal this 21st
 day of August in the year of our Lord One thousand
 and eight hundred and eighty eight, and in
 the One hundred and third year of the Indepen-
 dence of the United States of America,
