A.D. 1879. And I the party of the first of the
first part do agree and bound myself not
to interfere in any way with the party of the
second part in her management or control of
my said son so long as she may comply
with her agreement herein after written and
further to assist her so far as may be able
to prevail and make him obedient and to
treat her with the respect due by a word to
his education. And I Eliza Beth B. Britty
party of the second part for and in consider-
ation of the covenants aforesaid on the part
of the party of the first part, do covenant
by me and by these presents do bind myself
to and with the said E. S. Burnham to take up
my case, custody and charge his said son
and Richard E. C. Burnham to treat him with
as kind and gentle as though he were my
own son until he shall attain his majority
And for the true and faithful perform-
ance of each and every of the covenants and
agreements above written, We the parties
to these presents do bind ourselves and agree
each with the other, That the sum of two Thousand
Dollars as fixed settle and liquidated sum
agreed shall be paid to the other by the first
party failing to comply.

King and Paris King for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid and of the sum of One dollar to us in hand paid and before the sealing and deliv- ery of these presents, by Hancey King of the County of Greenville and State aforesaid has granted, bargained, sold and released and by these presents, do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said Hancey King all of our right title interest and estate of every nature whatsoever, of us, and to all and singular the premises herein after described to us. One half of what is left after the settlement of land, house, dwelling and being in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid
