King vs. et al of the County of Greenville and State aforesaid departed this life on the 28 day of April A.D. 1879 in testate and leaving considerable real and personal property; and whereas the heirs at law of said Geo. W. King have heretofore by parcel partitioned and divided the personal property; and whereas said heirs at law have agreed to partition and divide the real estate between themselves without resorting to the Court - executing reciprocal titles deeds there to their respective interests in said lands; therefore know all men by these presents that we Horace S. King Nancy King and Cassie King for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid and of the sum of One dollar to us in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by Charles S. King of the County of Greenville and State aforesaid, have granted, bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Charles S.
