distribution share in the Estate of my Father

the other Children in Four hundred acres
land more or less situate in Greenville
County on Evans River, possession given after
the death of my Mother, now a residuum of
said tract of land, same being all my right
title and claim in full of said property.
Together with all and singular the rights
members, hereditaments and appurtenances
to the said premises belonging, or in
anywise incident or affine thereto:

signs forever. And I do hereby bind my
