Dollars - to me paid by Jacob W. Eagle, in the State
aforesaid, have granted, bargained, sold, and released,
and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release
unto the said Jacob W. Eagle all my rights interest
and title in and to my undivided one half interest
in a certain tract or parcel of land situated lying
and being in the County and State aforesaid in
the Pickens Road - being all my interest in and to

a tract of Land conveyed to Jacob W. Eagle and
Henry G. Carter by J. A. Bonner in his own right
and as Trustee for Mrs. Rebecca C. Bonner and children
and recorded the 19th day of April 1883 in Book
Q page 93 office of Register of Deeds, County - having
