 grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said  
 Henry Carter all that lot or parcel of land sit-  
 uate in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid  
 in the Corporate limits of the City of Green-  
 ville, Beginning on Sandy Johnsons corner on  
 the East side of old Judge Lane, then on along said  
 Sandy Johnsons line to M<sup>c</sup> Daniels line, then on along  
 said M<sup>c</sup> Daniels line to a corner of Romulus Dabitt
