This agreement this day entered into between  
J. L. Walker of the first part of the state and  
County above mentioned and Lilly A. Nelson  
of the second part of the state and County  
aforesaid witnesses that the party of the  
first part agrees to lease to the party of  
the second part certain tracts of land  
to clear and put into a state of cultivation  
and to have and to hold for the term of three  
years all rent for all she clears in the year

1883 and 1884 for the term of 3 years next year  
Whether she will or fail in the year 1888, she  
further more agrees to clear two acres each year  
and to pay to the party of the first part the  
third of whatever grain or other produce she  
may raise at her time of harvest each year  
Clearing she also agrees to clear the land  
surrounding her premises in Greenville County.
