Elmathan D. Duckworth of Morehouse Parish in the
state of Louisiana and his wife Ann Amelia Sapphira
Duckworth (formerly Papp) of Greenville District, in
the state of South Carolina of the first part, and
Parkdale Durham Garrison of Greenville District
in the State of South Carolina of the second part
Witnesseth: Whereas the said Elmathan D. Duckworth
hath recently intermarried with the said Ann Amelia
Sapphira Duckworth, and whereas at the time of said
marriage the said Ann Amelia Sapphira Duckworth
was seized and possessed in fee simple in her own
right of the lot or tract of land and buildings thereon
Hereinafter described and conveyed, and whereas
by said marriage the marital rights of the said Elma-
thaw D. Duckworth hath attached in and to the said
premises, and whereas the said Elmathan D. Duckworth
being in easy circumstances and not in need of the
said property is desirous of releasing and conveying
his rights therein, in commission with ^{whom} of his said wife
to a trustee in trust for the sole, separate and exclu-
sive use, benefit and behoof of his said wife, and

and singular the premises parcel and lot of land situated

Greenville and Columbia Rail Road, in the District
of Greenville and State of South Carolina, containing
ten acres more or less, with the best crops and
improvements thereon, and adjoining lands of
John Westfield and said Parkdale Durham
Garrison, and being the same whereon the said
Mrs Ann Amelia Sapphira Duckworth has been
residing, together with all and singular the rights
members hereditaments and appurtenances to
the said premises belonging or in anywise inci-
dent or appertaining, To have and to hold all
and singular the premises before mentioned unto
the said Parkdale Durham Garrison his suc-
cessors heirs and assigns forever. But only for
and upon the following uses purposes and trusts,
and to and for and upon no other use purposes or
trust whatsoever, that is to say in trust for and to
the special use benefit and behoof of the said Ann
Amelia Sapphira Duckworth for and during the
term of her natural life, and in trust further that
at any time during the life of the said Mrs Ann
Amelia Sapphira Duckworth, the said Parkdale
Durham Garrison shall upon the written request
of the said Ann Amelia Sapphira Duckworth
sell and convey the said premises and appurten-
ances the proceeds as she may direct, and in trust
further that at any time during the life of the
said Ann Amelia Sapphira Duckworth she may
execute a paper in the nature of a last will and
testament disposing of the said premises after the
death of the said Ann Amelia Sapphira Duckworth
and that the said premises if thus disposed of shall
vest and be held after her death according to such
dispositions, and in trust further that if the said
Ann Amelia Sapphira Duckworth shall not by any
of the above named means dispose of the said
premises during her life, that the same shall at

equal shares in fee simple for
