E 97 1/2 to the corner of lot on New Street, thence N 15 1/2 E  
93 7 to a Stone 31, being on Edward Patterson's line, thence  
N 74 1/2 W 9 1/4 to a Stone 31, being Patterson's corner on Mrs  
Westmoreland's line, thence S 15 1/2 W 93 7 to the beginning  
corner, containing nine and eight tenths acres more
