 whereof is hereby acknowledged I have granted conveyed sold and delivered  
 and by these presents do grant convey sell and deliver unto the said  
*Walter J. Gibson* all of that certain piece parcel or tract of land  
 situate lying and being about *one and a half miles* South of *Greenville*  
 and containing *one hundred and fifty acres* more or less  
 Bounded on the North by the State Road on the West by lands of *Wm.*  
*G. Harrison* and by the Greenville Road on the South by lands of *Wm.*  
*McMitchell* and of *Geo. Westmoreland* the Mill tract and  
 on the East and North East by lands of *W. C. Morgan* and of *Wm.*

The said tract of land being composed of one hundred and ten acres of  
 the tract of 150 deeded to me by *Jos. Westmoreland* and on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of  
 February 1850. and of a tract of forty six acres deeded to me by said
